- 3. The third bit of information in that report should be any other money that will be spent to maintain the West Covina Sports Complex in fiscal year 2021-2022.
- 4. The report should inform this council as to the reason that Big League Dreams was built.
- 5. Why was the contract with the organization named Big League Dreams terminated and by which party?
- 6. Now that the complex exists, what is planned as to the future use of this facility?
- 7. The taxpayers of West Covina deserve an answer to each of these questions.
